Please note, withdrawal does not necessarily remove your Church/Ministry from our fellowship unless that is specifically expressed to us. Withdrawal will absolve your Church/Ministry and Church for All of any mutual responsibility or accountability to one another.

Section 1 – General Information

Our Vision: One Lord, One Body, One Church

⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. Ephesians 4:4-6 (New International Version)

Our Mission: To build love and unity across the world with whosoever believes in their heart and confesses with their lips Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour.

Definitions

We welcome our brothers and sisters to work alongside us in the Lord. Please look over the following information to help determine the level of involvement and commitment you are considering with Church For All International (CFAI).

1. FELLOWSHIP OF CHURCHES

Definition: Christian Church/ministry that want to work alongside us in a common purpose.

Objective: To work in a collaborative manner for the common good both locally and worldwide.

For example: Working together in outreach services, relief aid, vigils, volunteer support etc.

Fellowship churches include denominational and non-denominational Christian Churches that believe Jesus Christ is Lord and Saviour. We invite you to work alongside Church For All International in specific programs and outreaches.

2. SATELLITE CHURCHES AND MINISTRIES

Definition: Apostolic New Testament Churches and Ministries.

Objective: To be under the Apostolic covering and guidance of CFAI.

For example: 1. New satellite Churches planted by CFAI
2. Pre-existing ministries and churches brought under the covering of RCCI.

Jesus Is Our Example

Jesus set the example for all others when He said: ***“For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.”*** (Mark 10:45)

Everyone is equal, therefore leaders are not to be put on pedestals, they are servants and must serve with humility. We do not believe in ‘titles’, but do recognize an anointing (e.g. Pastor or Apostle). Leaders in the Church have duties and obligations to the Church. It is a privilege to serve not a right.

Like the first century Christians, the spiritual governance of the Church is a plurality of leaders (e.g. Apostles and Elders -which often include pastors). There is a plurality of Deacons for the administrative aspects of the Church. Plurality creates checks and balances (accountability to one another and the Church).

The Apostolic New Testament Church (ANTC) is built on Jesus. It is rooted in *love and united as one body under one Lord, Jesus Christ*. It is necessary to be in “one accord”. (Acts 2:46, KJV).

As an ANTC we believe in the five-fold ministry and the spiritual gifts.

Affirmation Statement for the Inclusion of All People

CFAI believes WHOSOEVER confesses the name of Jesus Christ is saved.

We believe in affirming all people without judgment, regardless of their nationality, tribe or tongue, gender, social/economic status, or sexual orientation whether Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender, Heterosexual or gender other. We believe Christ died for all and are saved unto eternal life when “whosoever” accepts Him as their personal Saviour, having confessed Him with their lips and believed in their hearts that Jesus Christ is Lord.

Statement Of Faith

- ✚ We believe in God the Father, Creator of Heaven and Earth.
- ✚ We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered for us under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and buried, and resurrected according to the Scriptures.
- ✚ We believe in the guidance of the Holy Spirit within every person who has been spiritually reborn.
- ✚ We believe in a literal, eternal Heaven and Hell.
- ✚ We believe repentance of sin and personal faith in Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord is the only way to be made a member of the Kingdom of God, both now and eternally.
- ✚ We believe it is God's will every believer be baptized in water and be filled daily with the Holy Spirit.
- ✚ We believe the Church of Jesus Christ is formed of all those who know Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour and Lord, regardless of denomination.
- ✚ We believe the Holy Bible contains the complete inspired written word of God to us and it is the basis for doctrine, reproof, correction and for instruction in right living.
- ✚ We believe in the literal second coming of Jesus Christ to earth and He shall rule as King over all the earth; there shall be no end to His Kingdom.

Section 2 - Satellite Churches

Part I – General Requirements For a Satellite of CFAI

Spiritual

1. Adhere to the Statement of Faith.
2. Teachings must be consistent with the Statement of Faith in Bible studies, sermons, ministries and other areas of Church life and activity.
3. Must agree to follow the principles of an Apostolic New Testament Church (with a plurality of leadership).
4. To remain accountable under the Apostolic covering of CFAI.
5. In the event of a young or new/small church without enough members, the Elders of CFAI will automatically serve as the covering for the satellite Church
6. Appointments of Elders/Pastors in satellite Churches planted by CFAI need to be addressed through the offices of CFAI in order to be approved by the Apostolic Covering
7. Satellites must be willing to work with CFAI toward reconciliation with other Churches, ministries and leaders should conflict, divisions or any other circumstance that threaten unity arise.

Administrative

1. Reports must be submitted regularly once a week. (See Form I.)
2. An annual report must be submitted for our AGM no later than March 31 of each year.
3. Deacons are to be elected by the congregation, but must be first approved by the elders before they serve as Deacons
4. Churches and Ministries must remain financially independent from CFAI.
5. To provide quarterly reports of all Church ministries

Representatives of CFAI will visit Churches and Ministries from time to time to encourage, teach, and disciple.

The above requirements are MANDATORY for all Satellite Churches under the CFAI covering.

Part II - Non Compliance and Cessation of Affiliation

CFAI will look at the overall compliance of the Church/Ministry throughout their association with CFAI to see if non-compliance has been an on-going problem.

In the event we do not hear from you, CFAI will do everything possible to communicate with your Church/Ministry. However, if we do not have any contact from you after a reasonable period of time, or, if after having made contact non-compliance continues, CFAI will make a unilateral decision about the continuation of our association.

If there are mitigating circumstances as to why your Church/Ministry is unable to comply with the requirements to submit reports and/or to communicate with CFAI please let us know the reason, in writing, as soon as possible.

We pray for continued unity in the Saints. We are under One Lord One Body One Church. May His Glorious Name continue to be praised in all the earth. Let the Heavens and Earth Rejoice and Shout Hallelujah to the King of Kings! Amen.
